Foster Dogs has designed a one-ofa-kind online database of active foster caretakers in the NYC area, available at no cost to local shelters and foster-based rescue groups. Thanks to Maddie's Fund, our Foster Roster earned a grant in support of these lifesaving efforts.

This program, developed jointly by Foster Dogs & Susie's Senior Dogs, connects celebrities and influencers with fantastic adoptable dogs from Animal Care Centers of NYC. "Famous Fosters" participants use their platforms to help promote fostering and adoption.



#### **FOSPICE**

This heartwarming program assists elderly and terminally ill dogs during their final months by sponsoring the dog's needs for the remainder of his or her life. Offering a comfortable way for the dog to feel spoiled with lots of treats, grooming, love, and a professional photo shoot! Aimed at bringing more awareness to the cause. Nearly 50 dogs have benefited from this highly specialized program, from 22 local groups, over five years.




#### LENDING LIBRARY
